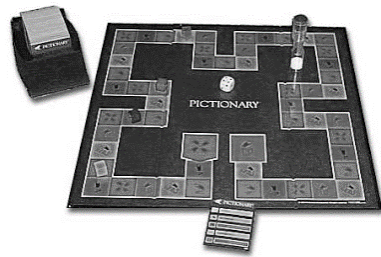

WW II AND PAXTONVILLE

Would you like to know more about your family members experience in WW II? Would you want to know what was happening right here in Paxtonville to support the war effort? 16 million men and women served in the USA armed forces in WW II about 18% of the total population. Millions of people worked in industry and volunteer organizations to support the war effort. 1940 Paxtonville had a population of approximately 400 souls, the WW II honor roll that used to be in front of the church contain the names of 72 men and women serving, also 18%. Many more supported the war effort in industry and volunteering. Today most folks do not know where or how their family member served or supported. The “Homefront” is a general term for all the folks at home working to support the war effort, it is rarely addressed and little appreciated. Join us as we help you obtain the information on WW II service and how this community nurtured its family members caught up in this huge event on Tuesdays, February 14, 21, 28 and March 7, 6-8 pm in the PUMC Fellowship Hall. A signup sheet for the class can be found in the hallway outside the sanctuary. There is a limit of 60 participants, so please register soon. The fee for the class is \$5.00 per person to help offset printing and other costs.
