Invitation to Prayer

Leader: After exploring the array of human emotions, we come to joy at last. Let us be careful here, that we understand the joy for which we pray. We do not merely pray for happiness, in the way that fireworks, pie, or Christmas lights make us happy. We want a joy that lasts. Nor do we pray to never experience other emotions; joy can be present even as fear, anger, disgust, and sadness are around. And we do not pray for a joy that is only from human origin. As Psalm 28 says, we want hearts “filled with joy” when the Lord is our strength. Happiness may come and go. Other emotions rise and fall. Today, we pray for a joy that stays constant in our very souls through Jesus Christ. In this prayer time we will begin with a time of silence, I will gather us into a corporate prayer, and then invite us to conclude together saying **The Lord’s Prayer**. Let us pray...

Together: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For yours is the kingdom, the power, and the glory forever. Amen
